



Responsibility Award 2021

The Bohdan Hawrylyshyn Family Foundation Award goes to civil society organizations whose activities are related to one or more points of the Declaration of Human Responsibilities. Applications for participation were submitted by 23 public organizations, and 15 participating organizations reached the final round based on the results of public voting.

The winners were announced on January 22 2022, on the Day of the Unification of Ukraine. The event championed the values of unity and responsibility as fundamental drivers for our country.

In addition to cash prizes of **100,000**, **50,000** and **25,000** hryvnias (first, second and third place respectively), the winners received a statuette created by the famous Ukrainian sculptor Oleh Pinchuk. The winners of the public vote were awarded a special prize from our partners the Fedir Shpyg Foundation.

The partners of the event were the Society of Ukrainians in Switzerland, Ukrainian Radio, UA: Suspilne, ISAR Ednannia, and the Fedir Shpyg Foundation.

Young Generation will Change Ukraine 2020/21

The program is for young patriotic Ukrainians who are active in public life, ready to be the driving force of effective change in Ukraine, and inspired by the the European experience. Launched in 2012 by the Bohdan Hawrylyshyn Family Foundation, the program brings together proactive youth to collaborate on their training.

The program contains 3 stages: training in local development schools, project implementation by program participants, and study of the European experience or the small grant.

The results of the program "Young Generation will Change Ukraine" 2020/2021 were presented in 2021. In total, 6 projects were supported by small grants, two groups of winners were formed for study trips abroad, and 6 participants received mentoring support from graduates of the previous years.

Young Generation will Change Ukraine. Poltava region 2021

During 2020 and 2021, the program "Young Generation will Change Ukraine" was implemented at the local level in the Poltava region. Training was aimed at young patriotic residents of Poltava region who are active in the public life of the region and ready to be the driving force of effective change.

In 2021, for the first time, the residents of Poltava region had the opportunity to vote for three settlements to become local development schools. Training took place in Myrhorod, Pyriatyn, and the village of Petrivka.

The winners were announced at a joint meeting of the 2020-2021 graduates of MZU-Poltava region. 12 projects were selected by expert evaluators, the authors of which received either a small grant or the opportunity to gain experience during a study trip abroad.

The program is supported by Aurora Multimarket, Poltava Business Association, and Endeavour.

Creative Youth will Change Ukraine

This Educational program on project management for young people from the cultural and creative industries was implemented with the support of the Ukrainian Cultural Foundation. In 2021, the program was held for the third time. In three years, "Creative Youth will Change Ukraine" has successfully graduated more than 400 participants, united by their desire for change and willingness to create these changes themselves. The program's methodology of teaching values-based project management was developed by certified facilitator, coach, and project trainer Dina Volynets.

After studying at the program, Roxolana began to design her own ideas in the project "Folk. Traditional. Modern." and later received support from experts of the Ukrainian Cultural Foundation within their scholarship program.

Roxolana's works are original. They immerse the viewer in a world of ancient symbols that have passed through the prism of the artist's own vision. And the program was the bridge that united Roxolana's art and her audience.

"I am very pleased with my participation in the program and the knowledge I have gained: organization, management, communication, reporting and fundraising in project management, communicated in accessible and "understandable" language. I gained not just knowledge but practical skills, which I immediately started using in my own art management".

The "Creative Youth will Change Ukraine" program is not just about project management; it's about values, including the values of communication and mutual support. "To this day I am friends with other program participants. I feel supported by them and by the organizers and curators of our training".



The chatbot "Project Guru" is an ancillary product developed within the program.





